Liberty Charter High School was established in August of 2001, providing the secondary education level for Liberty Charter School. Liberty Charter School is a K-12 public school that expects its students and its graduates to be role models of integrity in their conduct, academic excellence and community investment. The grades and credits students earn do not represent the hours they spent in a classroom, but measure the extent to which the credits students achieved through state standards and objectives or (as in the case of elective and elective courses) a particular teacher's standards and objectives. Students achieving A's for coursework have chosen to satisfy 90-100% of the required objectives for that course. Classes are 56 minutes long and all core classes as well as electives meet on a daily basis. All instructors have a college degree and are certified in their course areas. Concurrent college courses are sanctioned through Northwest Nazarene University (Nampa, Idaho) and Boise State University in coordination with subject-area professors.
